Introduction

- **1.** In Ephesians 5:15-17 says we are to walk in wisdom. Through the Spirit we can show this wisdom through family relationships. How can this be? It is through family we interact with society...
 - a. Through marriage we come in contact with our "in-laws"
 - **b.** Through children we develop relationships with those in their schools, neighborhood etc.
- 2. Thus through families we share the same principles of the gospel message (submission, love, sacrifice, obedience, honesty, fairness) are to be displayed in our relationships.

I. <u>Wives (5:22-24,33)</u>

- a. Wives Submit Yourselves
 - i. The reason is because of the Lordship of Christ and the headship of the man in Christ (5:22-23).
 - **ii.** Both husbands and wives must submit to Christ for the marriage to work in the design God created it for.
- b. Christians Marrying Christians
 - **i.** Beware of being "unequally yoked" with non-Christians (2 Cor 6:14-18). Submission to Christ is a must and when one spouse does not submit civil war can be begin without end.
 - ii. Christians who wish to marry need to begin on a strong foundation of God's Word and Will.

II. <u>Husbands (5:25-33)</u>

- a. Husbands Love Your Wives
 - i. Paul has a lot more to say to husbands than to wives. He set a very high standard for them telling them to love their wives even as Christ loves the church.
 - **ii.** Husbands are to love their wives so completely and so righteously that the wife needs to never fear or suffer from her life of submission.
- b. The Basis Of Love
 - i. Marriage was created to meet man's emotional needs. (Gen 2:18)
 - ii. Marriage was created to meet man's physical needs. (1 Cor 7:1-3)
 - iii. Marriage was created to fulfill a social purpose in having children (Gen 1:28)
 - iv. Marriage is based upon loving sacrificially (Eph 5:25) just as Jesus gave His life for the church to cleanse and keep her...
 - v. The husband's love is also to be sanctifying (Eph 5:26-27) meaning he is now set apart to belong to his wife and the wife is set apart to belong to her husband.
 - vi. Today Jesus cleanses the church through the word and truth (John 17:17) The love of a husband for his wife ought to help cleanse them so that they can walk with God.
 - **vii.** A husband's love should also be satisfying (5:28-30). They are now one flesh in marriage so that whatever he does for his wife is also for himself and vice versa.
 - viii. Love is the pillar of the marriage and it truly protects from sin and temptation.
 - **ix.** If Christian husbands and wives have the power of the Spirit to enable them and the example of Jesus to encourage them then they will be joyful, thankful, submissive and loving.
