#### Introduction

- In the John 10 Jesus paints a picture of being the "Good Shepherd" and to see Jesus clearly we can open Psalm 23. In Psalm 23 we see what a Good Shepherd looks like...
  - a. Provider (v1); Nourishes (v2); Restores (v3); Guides (v4); lives for the sheep (v5-6)

## I. I AM The Good Shepherd (v11)

- a. What is the cost of being the Good Shepherd?
  - i. The cross, His life! Jesus loves us and wants to lead us through life and give us real life in the fullest sense!
  - ii. Jesus shows that He is fully committed in our lives

# II. <u>The Hired Hand (v12-13)</u>

- a. Cares Nothing For The Sheep
- **b.** Who is the hired hand today?
  - i. Is there anyone trying to tell you what to do all the time? How about the TV?
  - ii. It tells us what to do, what to buy, how we should vote, how we should act etc.
  - iii. But what happens when life gets hard? Will they be there in the hospital with you?Will they be there when you hurt? NO for when the wolves come they flee!
- c. Jesus bought us to be His own
  - i. We have been bought by His blood on the cross. He offers us God and a life with God so that when troubles enter into our lives Jesus is there in our time of need.
  - ii. Jesus is the committed shepherd who loves us and cares for us.

### III. <u>To Know Jesus (v14-18)</u>

- a. A Picture of Intimacy & Relationship
  - i. Jesus by the cross has proclaimed His love for us!
  - ii. Jesus has proven to us that we are valuable to God and wants what is best for us
  - iii. Jesus and God want us to walk with them in life; to become like them
- **b.** The Other Sheep

### IV. <u>What Should We Absorb?</u>

- a. Lesson About Sacrifice
  - i. Jesus showed us His love by His sacrifice. We too can do the same!
  - ii. Sacrifice means we have our priorities set with God's will
  - iii. Sacrifice helps us to see what is valuable in life and what is not
  - iv. Sacrifice helps us to surrender to leadership of Jesus as the Good Shepherd
    - **1.** John 15:13-14 Jesus has set the standard
    - 2. Luke 9:23-25 Is our way to follow His example
- b. The Challenge
  - i. Do an act of kindness because of the love Jesus has given to you
  - ii. Do them praising Jesus giving Him all the credit
  - iii. Let's connect what we do or say with Jesus
- c. Will you let Jesus be your Good Shepherd? Will you follow?
