I. Paul Thankful For Christ

- a. 1 Corinthians 15:53-57
 - i. In salvation found in Christ Paul was thankful for two great things...
 - 1. The empty grave!
 - **2.** The eternal gift!
- **b.** Paul's life that lead to being thankful for Christ...
 - i. Paul's hatred of Christ before the cross Php 3:5-6; Matthew 12:14
 - ii. Paul's friends had crucified Jesus John 18:3
 - iii. Then Jesus came back to life Matthew 28:11-14
 - iv. Paul guards the coats of those who stone Stephen Acts 8:1
 - v. Paul seeks to put many to death Acts 8:3; 9:1-2
 - vi. Paul meets Jesus on the road to Damascus Acts 9:3-9
 - vii. Paul now knew Christ was alive and it changed him forever Php 3:1-11
- c. 2 Corinthians 9:15
 - i. The Eternal Gift! Paul had tried so hard before, so religious
 - ii. Paul found that salvation was a gift to receive Eph 2:4-9

II. Paul Thankful For Christians

- **a.** Philippians 1:3-4
 - i. Paul had a great love for the saints Rom 1:8
 - ii. Jesus taught that when we love each other we prove to be His disciples John 13:35
- b. Philippians 4:1
 - i. Love longs for fellowship 1 John 4:7-12

III. Paul Thankful Constantly

- a. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18
 - i. In everything Paul gave thanks. The secret to being thankful and content in all circumstances is found in the theme of the letter...
 - ii. 1 Thessalonians 5:1-11 Christ will return
 - iii. 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 Every day the Lord is expected
