## **Introduction**

- 1. The wise men who visited Jesus after His birth are a mystery in many ways. We don't know exactly where they came from, or how many men there were, or how they knew of the star signaled the birth of Christ.

- c. How long since you read your bible in your house? 2 Timothy 3:14-17; Deuteronomy 6:4-9
- **d.** How long since you praised Go in song in your house? Colossians 3:14-16
- e. Is the presence of Jesus sensed in your house?

## III. It Is Wise To Recognize Jesus As Lord In Your House

- a. Gifts of gold: the symbol royalty What is your gift? Matthew 22:37-40
- **b.** Gifts of frankincense: used for incense in the temple
  - i. Speaks of our Lord's High Priestly work for us Hebrews 9:11-14; 7:25
- c. Gifts of Myrrh: speaks of the suffering and death of Christ Hebrews 9:24-28
