 - a. Redeemed, Rescue, Restore
 - b. Salvation, Revelation, Victory
 - c. Person, Proclamation, People
- II. **7 Words That Give Us The Comprehensive Nature Of The Gospel**
 - a. Plan – Titus 1:2; 1 Peter 1:20; Ephesians 3:11
 - b. Person- (Jesus Christ) Matthew 1:21-25
 - c. Event – Jesus came down from Heaven for us
 - d. Achievement – 1 Corinthians 15:1-4
 - e. Offer – (Of Forgiveness) – 1 Peter 5:10
 - f. Response – Romans 1:5-6; 16:25-26
 - g. Relationship – 1 Peter 3:18; Galatians 2:5,11-15
 - i. If we could sum up the gospel in one verse it could be Mark 10:45 for this verse is the heart and soul of Jesus and ought to be our heart and souls too...
- III. **7 Complimentary Relationships With Jesus And Us Through The Gospel**
 - a. Son of Man – He is our fellow man
 - i. Romans 8:3; 1 Timothy 2:5; Hebrews 2:17; 4:15; Isaiah 53; John 11:35
 - b. For The Son Of Man – He is our God
 - i. John 1:1-18; Colossians 1:15-23; Hebrews 1; Philippians 2:5-11; Revelation 1:9-20
 - ii. Hand is a perfect acronym for Jesus and His Deity
 1. H – stands for divine honor (John 5:23)
 2. A – stands for divine attributes
 3. N – Divine names – Lord, King, Messiah
 4. D – Divine Deeds
 5. S – Sits On Right Hand Of God (Acts 2:30-35)
 - c. Our Servant – He came to serve not be served
 - i. John 13; Hebrews 12:2
 - d. Jesus Served By Giving His Life – He was our sacrifice
 - i. Propitiation (Romans 3:23-24; 1 John 2:2), Purchased (1 Corinthians 6:20; 7:23), Justified (Romans 5:1-2), Family (2 Corinthians 5:15-21)
 - e. Life Was A Ransom – He paid our debt that we could never pay
 - i. John 19:30
 - f. Ransom For The Many – Matthew 11:28-30; Revelation 22:17
 - g. For Even – Our example (John 13; 1 Peter 2:21-25)
