#### Introduction

1. In our study thus far we have examined what the Christian heart is and discussed the subject of purity and how it affects the heart. Today we want to take a look at God's part in purifying our hearts...

## I. Why We Need God For Pure Hearts

- **a.** Because An Impure Heart Will Keep Us From God's Presence
- **b.** Because Sin Separates Us From God
  - i. Romans 3:23; 1 John 1:8-10; Romans 3:9; Galatians 3:22; Isaiah 59:2 they all tell us we are under sin and sin keeps away from God
- c. Because Of The Glory Of God
  - i. In Psalms 15 & 24:3-5 both describe the quality of the one who dwells in the presence of God. It involves "clean hands and a pure heart."
  - ii. Habakkuk 1:13; Proverbs 15:29; Psalm 5:4-5; Isaiah 6:1-6; 1 Peter 1:16
- d. Because We Want To Approach God
  - i. To do so we must have our sins taken care of (Romans 7:24)

### II. God & Our Purification

- a. He Sent His Son!
  - i. Romans 7:25 gives the answer of what or whom can take away sin and our "wretchedness"
  - ii. John 3:16; Romans 5:6-9; Hebrews 9-10
    - 1. Jesus provided the sacrifice needed to cleanse our hearts from sin (Hebrews 10:10-14)
    - 2. His blood purifies us (Hebrews 9:14; Ephesians 2:13; Revelation 1:5)
    - **3.** How do we come in contact with His blood? Acts 22:16; Romans 6:3-4; 1 Peter 3:20-21; Romans 10:10; Acts 15:9
- **b.** He Sent His Word!
  - i. The Word of God is PURE (Psalm 119:9,11; 1 Peter 2:2)
  - ii. James 1:21-25 It is through His word that we can learn HOW to be saved and STAY saved
- c. He Has Given Us A Conscience
  - i. Romans 2:13; 13:5; 1 Timothy 1:5
- d. Continually Needing Purification
  - i. Even after we have been purified by God through obeying the gospel, we get soiled again time to time with sin (1 John 1:7-10; Acts 8:22)

# III. What Does This Mean?

- **a.** We Can Have Hope there is a solution to the problem of sin in our lives (Romans 3:24-25; Ephesians 2:8; Isaiah 1:18)
- **b.** Our life Can Be Lived With Real Purpose
- **c.** We OWE Him! Consider what God has done for us, it is not too much to serve Him with purity of heart (Hebrews 5:9; 1 Peter 1:15-16; 2 Peter 3:14)
