He had a Spirit of Service. "Whosoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant: Even as the Son of Man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister and to give His life a ransom for many" (Matthew 20:27-28).

He had a Spirit of Obedience. Jesus prayed, saying, "O, my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from Me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou will" (Matthew 26:39).

He had a Spirit of Optimism. "Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us. Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is sat down at the right hand of the throne of God" (Hebrews 12:1-2).

He had a Spirit of Forgiveness. While dying on the cross Jesus prayed, "Father forgive them; for they know not what they do" (Luke 23:34).

These are but a few of the characteristics of Christ, but hopefully this will challenge us to see the need for Bible study. If you and I must be like Him in order to go to heaven, then we must know Him. See you in Bible class!
