

The Apostle Paul challenged the Corinthians to "Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith." - Christians will be watchful, steadfast, brave and strong in the faith. (1 Cor. 16:13)
- One must not be moved away, but remain grounded in the faith. (Col. 1:23)
- One who receives Christ as Lord, will be established in the faith. (Col. 2:6-7)
- Deacons who serve well, develop a great boldness in the faith. (1 Tim. 3:13)
- False teachers should be warned, so to remain sound in the faith. (Titus 1:13)
- Brotherly love should always be shared by those in the faith. (Titus 3:15)

• Satan can be resisted by those who are steadfast in the faith. (1 Peter 5:8-9)

Successful Christianity is not defined by man's view of greatness, but by humble service to the Lord which is constantly practiced. To remain "in the faith", I must practice the faith. God has provided His saving grace, through Christ, accessed by faith. (Eph. 2:1-10)
